



Job Title: Intern – Junior Project Engineer

Company Background:

Job Description:

The intern shall report to the lead project manager and lead technical manager and will help with all aspects of project delivery. Tasks will include (but may not be limited to):

- Supporting with project management and preparation of project plans and WBS
- Energy demand modelling
- Client and supplier engagement;
- Data management and analysis
- Support on project deliverables in a variety of projects
- Inputting to proposals and reports

Additionally, due to the lean structure of our team the intern will support across other aspects of the business where required.
